



MUW EMPLOYEES FEDERAL CREDIT UNION'S RAY INDUCTED INTO HALL OF FAME

Biloxi, Miss. (5/17/18) - - Mississippi University for Women Employees Federal Credit Union Director Wanda Ray has been inducted into the Mississippi Credit Union Hall of Fame. Created in 1993, the Mississippi Credit Union Hall of Fame is the state's highest credit union honor, recognizing individuals that have devoted their life to the philosophy and success of credit unions at the local, state or national level.

Ray has devoted her life to the Mississippi University for Women Employees Federal Credit Union and its sponsor organization, the Mississippi University for Women. At her retirement from the university, Ms. Ray was recognized with a conference room as well as an annual art scholarship named in her honor.

Ray joined the credit union the year it opened in 1965. In 1980 she became a director as well as the chairman of the supervisory committee, two positions in which she actively serves today.
