



TWIN STATES FEDERAL CREDIT UNION'S JOHNSON INDUCTED INTO HALL OF FAME

Biloxi, Miss. (5/17/18) - - Twin States Federal Credit Union Director David Johnson has been inducted into the Mississippi Credit Union Hall of Fame. Created in 1993, the Mississippi Credit Union Hall of Fame is the state's highest credit union honor, recognizing individuals that have devoted their life to the philosophy and success of credit unions at the local, state or national level.

David Johnson was one of the original members of Twin States Federal Credit Union, joining when the credit union still operated out of a one-room office on the grounds of their sponsor company. In 1975, David became a member of the supervisory committee, and in 1981 he was elected to the board of directors, where he currently serves as vice chairman.

Through the years David has loyally attended the Mississippi Credit Union Association Annual Meeting & Convention, enjoying it as an opportunity to interact with credit union peers and learn new ideas to help improve his credit union.

His commitment to seek out and embrace new ideas has been a catalyst for Twin States Federal Credit Union's grown to a full-service credit union offering more products and services to its 1,500 members than some credit unions twice its size.

Those that know David describe him as a strong believer in the credit union philosophy and someone who is always ready to participate in activities promoting the credit union or supporting the community.
